### *White*

- 400 **Saint Aubin Paul Pillot, 2010** £46.00  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
Subtle hints of violets and ripe orchard fruit on the nose. The palate is crisp and fresh with vibrant citrus fruit great structure, balance and a mouth watering long finish.
- 401 **Meursault Villages, Domaine Michelot, 2010** £49.00  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
A rich and sumptuous Meursault, with honey, pastry, lime and hazelnut flavours on a round frame. Beautifully balanced, this is vibrant and snappy, ending with a mouthwatering finish.
- 402 **Pulligny Montrachet Village Etienne, Sauzet, 2010** £56.00  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
A stunning wine from vineyards located in the appellation of Puligny-Montrachet, light yellow to lime green in colour, rich ripe fruit and honeyed nose. The palate displays rich notes of peach, pear, citrus fruits and some honeysuckle.

### *Red*

- 403 **Château du Moulin Rouge, 2010** £36.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
A ROSL favourite, Chateau du Moulin Rouge is a charming estate situated between Margaux and Beychevelle St Julien. The estate has been in the same family for 13 generations and pre-dates the similarly named establishment in Paris. Whilst still youthful, this wine is drinking well already and provides a great foil for red meats and hard cheeses.
- 404 **Château Belgrave 5eme Cru Classe Haut Medoc, 2003** £42.50  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Situated next to the commune of St Julien and particularly Château Lagrange, the terroir of Château Belgrave is certainly up there. Boasting thick brambly fruit and hints of star anise, this is a match for any red meat dish.
- 405 **Château Batailley 5eme Cru Classe Haut Medoc, 2002** £50.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Château Batailley is one of the oldest estates in the Médoc. The name is derived from the battle (bataille) that took place where the château and vineyard are today.
- 406 **Château Pontet Canet, 1998** £75.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Pontet Canet's 78 hectare estate borders that of Mouton Rothschild and has performed well above its 5th Growth classification since the 70's. The 1998 is a powerful effort with bold dark fruits and typical cigar box notes.

- 407 **Château Clos Fortet Grand Cru St Emilion, 2001** £89.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Clos Fourtet, called 'Camp Fourtet' in the Middle Ages, was once a fort designed to protect the town of St Emilion. In more peaceful times, this Château produces expressive Merlot dominated wines, supported by 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cabernet Franc  
Round dark fruits dominate on the palate with well integrated oak character typifying this sometimes undervalued and elegant vintage.
- 408 **Château Léoville Barton 2eme Cru Classe St Julien, 2003** £95.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Château Léoville Barton is the smaller portion of the great Leoville estate, owned by the Barton family since 1826. 2003 was an uncharacteristically hot vintage, producing some real blockbuster, fruit driven wines - and this does not disappoint. Rich dark berries and chocolate notes dominate the pallet with plenty of cedar and spiciness completing the equation.
- 411 **Château Leoville Las Cases, 1997** £130.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Leoville Las Cases is one of the finest estates in St Julien, renowned for its elegance and aromatic character of its wines. The 1997 vintage is approaching full maturity showing dark berry and blueberry fruit with hints of anise, leather and spice. The finish is well rounded with refined tannins and persistent fruit to the end.
- 409 **Château Lynch Bages 5eme Cru Classe Pauillac, 2003** £142.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Château Lynch Bages consistently punches above its 5th Cru Classe status and is now generally perceived as being of 2nd Cru Classe quality. Although this wine has already accumulated over 10 years of bottle age, it is still youthful and robust in character, showing sweet dark fruits, leather and spicy edges. More than a match for the heartiest of dishes!
- 410 **Château Haut Brion 1er Cru Classe Graves, 1997** £303.00  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Though not a classic vintage, the top estates produce fantastic wines from year to year and this wine certainly delivers. As one of only five 1er Grand Cru wines, Château Haut Brion exemplifies top class claret, a blinding balance of power and elegance – a real treat.
