



THE BLACK BULL

The Black Bull's wine list took a change for the better after the first lockdown. Previously the list was a 150+ wine book, covering many varieties, styles, and regions of the wine world.

Great for those who want to study a wine list, but many hidden gems could get lost in its pages. The main list is now, like the food menu, ever changing showcasing low production wines alongside some classics in the industry focusing on what's best at the time with the seasons in mind. However, we've still maintained the use of our extensive cellar for those wanting to explore even further, and allowing us to develop our offering too.

The first thing we don't do is litter the list with the usual suspects. As certain wine merchants tell you need to include a Pinot Grigio, Prosecco a Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. That's not to say they never appear, if they are good, but it's certainly not a first thought when developing the wine list. However, our guests need to be made comfortable about trying something new. No wine list should be inaccessible or produced to confuse the customer. If we don't have a traditional option for a Sauvignon, we should be able to offer something with some similar flavours or play what attracts them to that wine in the first place. Like Nina's food, things are a little different and this should reflect in the wine list and all the drinks.

The wine list is a very personal list to me, something that takes up a lot of thought, and is as much part of my own journey as the restaurants wine list. It would be easier to have a fixed list but the passion we have for the wines we offer would not shine through. The everchanging wines by the glass allow both staff and customers to sample something different and build their own palette. I also must bear certain customers in mind, and include some 'comfort classics,' much like the Beef Pie on the A La Carte menu. The focus certainly tilts towards the old world rather than the new world, organic, biodynamic, 'natural' wines, and a preference for smaller producers. I think people forget wine production is just another type of farming, and as with all the produce we use those farming processes are important.

France and Italy, classically, do take up a good chunk of the list, some fantastic producers in both countries producing some of the world's best organic, biodynamic, and natural wines. However, you will see much more of a focus too on Germanic, Central and Eastern European wines.

Wines that haven't modernised like other countries, and traditional styles of minimum intervention wine is back in fashion. It's this 'minimum intervention' that really interests, wines that are left to sing for themselves not tuned with added sugars, sulphites, colours, and other flavours to mask its identity. We embrace cloudy, funky wines but we need to communicate this to the customer as many are not used to this concept yet.

We always have a decent selection of Orange, something many believe to be new but is age old, and sometimes these flavours can present a challenge to a new palate. It can take some experimentation to fall in love with some of these wines but when people do, they want to discover more.

Outside, in our Stables and Meadow concept, we have a much more laid-back approach to the wine program. Much more about fun, refreshing wines that match our BBQ and Sourdough Pizzas but still with the importance of flavour and provenance. We even have a couple of wines on keg which keeps the wine fresh, chilled and is much better for the environment in terms of packaging. Something many wine connoisseur may turn their nose up at, but it really works well within this concept.

Flavour, like anything we serve, is at the forefront of what hits the list. It needs to be good no matter whether it is organic or biodynamic or there's little point. There are some 'natural wines' out there that are all fashion and no flavour, so they don't make the list.

The world of natural wines is fascinating and has taken off in the trendier parts of the world, but you still must acknowledge the importance of more conventional wines. Those that still have good practice farming methods and

*actually produce good wine. I think if you understand both sides of the wine world then you can achieve a well-balanced wine list, which we hope we do at the **Black Bull Inn**.*
