Red Wines

Upper Rectory House Red 250ml* Bottle £4.95 £14.95

Las Pampas Malbec 2017 £5.75 £16.25

Mendoza, Argentina 13%

A rich, full red with lovely damson and plum fruits. Soft tannins with a subtle hint of underlying oak. A great value wine. Medium-bodied.

Campo Viejo Rioja 2016 £17.50

Logrono, Spain 13.5%

This Tempranillo has a pronounced aroma of rich red fruits with a subtle sweet note of vanilla and spices. The palate is fresh, soft and velvety with flavours of redcurrants, vanilla and chocolate leading to a long and elegant finish.

Piccini, Chianti Classico – DOCG 2014 £18.50 Italy

Having made wine in Bordeaux, Argentina and elsewhere in Italy, Antonella joined Piccini in 2006 to work with Mario and Martina Piccini. This Chianti is a typical ruby red Sangiovese based wine with aromas of violets and cherries and a hint of earthy spice.

Cono Sur Pinot Noir 2016 £21.95

Colchagua Valley, Chile 13%

A fresh voluptuous Pinot with rich notes of cherry, blackberries and plum together with a balanced, ripe palate.

Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2012 £25.95

Appellation St. Emilion Grand Cru Controlée 13%

Bordeaux, France

Medium to deep purple red colour. Vibrant, vivid red fruit aromas. The wine has a lovely fresh acidity and a balanced to warm alcohol. The lovely clean fruit is supported by lots of fine pip tannins, making the long finish a blend of red fruit flavours and savoury tannins.

La Croix des Papes 2012 £29.95

Chateauneuf du Pape AC

Rhone Valley, France 13.5%

Ripe black fruit aromas are offset by notes of spice, leather, coffee and pepper. Rich, intense fruit flavours ae set in a firm yet ripe tannic structure with a complex finish.

Tenuta Pule 2012 £36.95

Amerone Della Valpolicella Classico

Valpolicella, Italy 16%

Amerone, the big brother of Valpolicella is one of Italy's supreme wines. Deep and intensely fruity wine. The noble, silky and lively aroma of blueberries, blackberries and spices.

Grand Cru Saint-Emilion 2012 £46.95

Château Teyssier

Saint-Emilion, France 13%

This is a soft, silky style of Saint-Emilion, made by Englishman Jonathan Maltus. It has good plummy fruit, plenty of weight mid-palate, and an easy-going, positive finish. It is a wine that can be enjoyed young.

Italy 12%

Italy's most popular is produced from the Pinot Grigio varietal. This wine hails from the northeast region of Veneto and Friuli. A light, crisp white wine.

Hardys Crest Chardonnay Sauvignon Blanc 2016 £17.25

Soft and fruity, intense peach flavours.

Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2016 £20.95

A refreshing light bodied Sauvignon Blanc with zesty peach, citrus fruit and gooseberry flavours

Muscadet Sevre & Maine Sur Lie 2016 £21.95

Domaine Le Fief De La Brie

Loire Valley, France 12%

An attractive white displaying citrus fruits with crisp acidity. The wine is aged on its lees, or sediment, 'Sur Lie', for six months to impart more body to the wine.

Viognier, Cono Sur 2016 £22.95

Colchagua Valley, Chile 13.5%

This Viognier exhibits sweet fruity aromas of apricots, citrus and peaches, combined with pleasant oak notes. Fresh and lively in mouth, this wine, with concentrated stone fruit flavours, is fresh, tasty, full and savoury. Of great character, density and structure, with a good acidity level and great persistence.

Italy 11%

Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

Comte de Senneval, Brut NV £27.95

Reims, France 12.5%

This Champagne has a fine bouquet, with elegant and complex fruit flavours on the palate.

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut NV £56.95

Reims, France 12%

On the eye, Yellow Label is a beautiful golden-yellow colour. When you take in the aroma you initially sense white fruits and raisins, then vanilla and later of brioche. On the palate you receive freshness and forcefulness that is so typical of Yellow Label with a symphony of fruit taste following on.
