1. **LADERA VERDE CHARDONNAY 2013/14, CONCHA Y TORO, CHILE** GLS £6.00 £18.00
Ripe with fresh, tropical fruit aromas. A lively and well-balanced dry wine from Chile's infamous Central Valley.
2. **W.KLUG SAUVIGNON/CHARDONNAY 2012, VIN DE PAYS D'OC, FRANCE** GLS £6.00 £19.00
A particularly attractive soft, dry blend of classic white grapes produced in the warmth of the Languedoc in southern France.
3. **LA SCALA PINOT GRIGIO 2013, ITALY** GLS £7.00 £19.00
Delicately aromatic, dry and refreshing from the Veneto region. A delicious appetiser on its own or with food.
4. **DOMAINE DU TARIQUET SAUVIGNON 2013, FRANCE** GLS £7.00 £20.00
A bouquet of intense floral notes with mineral aromas followed by a dominant sensation of ripe grapes. Good intensity with an abundance of freshness.
5. **FREEDOM CROSS CHENIN BLANC 2014, SOUTH AFRICA** £19.00
Fresh ripe apple mingles with tropical fruit flavours on the palate. The finish is crisp, dry and refreshing thanks to some beautifully balanced acidity.
6. **VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI CLASSICO 2013, ITALY** £20.00
A taut, focused white with an attractive, lemony scent. Flavours of ripe baked apples & peaches, kept fresh with a nip of apple peel & a sprig of mint and dill. Dry.
7. **VIÑA GRACIA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2013, CHILE** £24.00
Bright greeny gold in colour, mouth-wateringly fresh and very fruity with notes of apple, citrus and melon.
8. **GAVI DI GAVI 2012/13, MANFREDI, ITALY** £27.00
A very well balanced wine with plenty of peach fruit flavour that combines elegantly with a dry finish to bring great balance.
9. **MUSAR JEUNE WHITE 2013, LEBANON** £27.00
Aromas of pineapples, lychees and white peaches. The palate is smooth, full-bodied and concentrated. A silky texture, refined acidity and dry refreshing finish.
10. **OMAHU CHARDONNAY 2012, PASK WINERY, NEW ZEALAND** £28.00
This Chardonnay has power and finesse. Intense lemon and lime fruit characters are complemented by fine, new oak and creamy yeast notes.
11. **MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON 2012/13, ALAN MCCORKINDALE, NEW ZEALAND** £31.00
Intensely aromatic; this wine bursts with flavours of gooseberry and passion fruit with hints of hawthorn and citrus. Dry, vibrant and fruity with racy acidity.

<i>A first-class Sauvignon Blanc: herbal, smoky, minerally. Aromas of gooseberry, ripe green fruit and citrus. Medium-bodied with a creamy texture.</i> | £33.00 |
| 14. VINHAS VELHAS BRANCO 2012, LUIS PATO, PORTUGAL
<i>Orange oil, peach and citrus with nutty aromas on the nose. Effortlessly balanced, easy and caressing on the palate. A textured and sophisticated white.</i> | £37.00 |
| 15. POUILLY FUISSE VIEILLES VIGNES 2011, DOMAINE GONON, FRANCE
<i>A complex nose of citrus, white flowers and hints of vanilla. Rich and full on the palate with melon, tropical fruits and a streak of minerality. Creamy & savoury.</i> | £39.00 |
| 16. CHABLIS 1ER CRU VAU DE VEY 2012, DOMAINE DE MALANDES, FRANCE
<i>A ripe but completely classic green fruit and oyster shell nose compliments the delicious bone dry flavours and minerality accompanied by a long, delicate finish.</i> | £47.00 |
